Taiwan Ministry of Foreign Affairs now provides e-Visa for delegates to attend MWIA 2022 and we are obliged to apply the e-code for you which is an important key while you apply the e-Visa. If you would like to apply for the e-Visa, please provide the following required documents (clear and legible) by email to the 2022 Congress of the Medical Women's International Association Secretariat before April 30th, 2022.

1. Passport copy with Personal information page
2. Flight itinerary (issued by an airline company or travel agency)
3. Hotel reservation (issued by a hotel or travel agency)

Once your e-Code is approved, we will send an e-Code to you for you to apply the e-Visa online, kindly refer to visawebapp.boca.gov.tw to fill out the e-Visa applications and complete the payment of application fee online.
